Summary of application and Completeness Question 4 Response:

A full review Certificate of Need ("CN") application has been submitted by Monmouth Medical Center, Inc. ("MMC") to relocate selected services from its existing, licensed acute care hospital facility in Long Branch ("MMC Long Branch") to a new, second acute care hospital building located five miles away on the old Fort Monmouth in Tinton Falls, referred to as the Vogel Medical Campus ("VMC").

In response to the round 3 completeness questions received on December 17, 2024 and responded to on February 26, 2025, the CN was reframed with the proposed changes in the CN application project scope calling for an existing general hospital to relocate the majority of its acute care services to a new campus ("VMC") while maintaining a satellite emergency room (SED), an observation unit with 24 beds, inpatient psychiatric beds and outpatient psychiatric services, clinics, outpatient surgical and imaging services at the MMC Long Branch campus to ensure access is sustained to residents of this community.

On June 19, 2025, the Department subsequently asked twelve (12) additional clarifying questions. It is understood that these questions and all responses provided by the applicant will be made part of the CN application. The applicant has repeated these twelve (12) questions and provided its response below in Q & A format below.

The N.J. Department of Health (Department), Division of Certificate of Need and Licensing, has the following third round of questions regarding this application. These questions follow in bold with applicant responses.

- 1) Please confirm that the following services would remain at the Long Branch campus and provide the rationale for keeping each service in Long Branch rather than relocating to the new Fort Monmouth campus:
 - Emergency Services (Satellite Emergency Department)
 - Observation beds
 - Inpatient psychiatric beds and outpatient psychiatric services
 - Clinics
 - Outpatient/same-day surgerycenter
 - Imaging services

Response:

The applicant confirms the services listed above will remain at the Long Branch campus.

To sustain access for services most in demand by the community, the Long Branch Campus will continue to provide key services including a Satellite Emergency Department, outpatient services, an observation unit with 24-beds for emergency and same day surgery patients as needed, all inpatient and outpatient behavioral health services, outpatient surgical services in the Cranmer Surgery Center with four operating rooms, clinics, and a-full array of imaging services. MMC remains committed to the residents and City of Long Branch. This commitment extends to supporting the creation of a vibrant community around the hospital services provided at the Long Branch campus.

Operating a SED demonstrates MMC's commitment to the Long Branch communities in the continuation of easily accessible emergency services. Maintaining outpatient surgical and imaging services ensures convenient, local access to more frequently needed diagnostic and same day procedural health care services. Observation beds will support the SED, outpatient and same-day surgical services.

As previously reviewed for the service area, health care service trends project a decrease in demand for inpatient services and continued increase in demand for outpatient and observation services. Data projected a 4% growth in 5 years and a 5% growth in 10 year for overall outpatient volumes in the Long Branch zip codes and conversely a 4% and 7% decrease in inpatient volumes for 5 years and 10 years respectively. Hence, this proposed project maintains key outpatient services at the Long Branch campus supporting current and expected future service needs. Please refer to the response to Question #3 for specifics regarding outpatient clinics and services.

Maintaining behavioral health services at the Long Branch location is aligned with data that demonstrates the highest volume patient origin for the behavioral health service line inpatient admits at MMC between 2019 and 2023 originated from the Long Branch zip code of 07740 followed by proximate zip codes of Asbury Park (07712), Neptune City (07753) and Eatontown (07724). The applicant seeks to continue to locate this specialized care in its Long Branch campus to be conveniently accessible to where the majority of current demand and utilization has originated.

2) Please confirm that you plan to operate the Long Branch facility as a licensed hospital-based, off-site facility of the new Fort Monmouth hospital.

Response:

The applicant confirms.

3) Please provide a more detailed description of which types of outpatient clinics would operate at the Long Branch campus and a rationale for each.

Response:

A full range of medical and surgical specialty clinics including Surgery, Ortho/Peds & Adult, Cardiac, Urology, ENT, Gastro, Endo, Pain, Geriatric and the Sleep Lab will continue to be available at the Long Branch campus. MMC will continue to collaborate and maintain existing relationships such as with Monmouth Family Health Center ("MFHC"), a Federally Qualified Health Center serving the Long Branch NJ area and surrounding communities, joint ventures and physician practices. MFHC is also an important teaching site for clinic rotations for MMC. Additionally, OB, Pediatrics, Medicine and Dentistry are provided in partnership with MFHC, described in response to #5.

While acute care is more often a unique and infrequent episode of care, outpatient services tend to be ongoing care, and as a result the applicant feels it is important to sustain those existing dynamics in the community. Keeping these clinics accessible to the community further demonstrates MMC's commitment to provide convenient and accessible care to the community across the continuum.

- 4) Please confirm that the following full-service general hospital designations would be provided at the new Fort Monmouth campus:
 - Regional Perinatal Center
 - Children's Hospital
 - Primary Stroke Center

Response:

The applicant confirms that the general hospital designations will relocate with the medical/surgical, pediatric, neonatal services to the Vogel Medical Campus ("VMC") in Tinton Falls.

The obstetrical and pediatric inpatient services will be provided at the VMC location inclusive of the Children's Hospital and Regional Perinatal Center designation. Stroke services supporting the Stroke Center also will be provided at the relocated hospital VMC facility. Policies to ensure stroke, obstetrics, pediatric patient are cared for at the appropriate site will be developed to triage and transfer. Stroke services are exempt from CN and require only a licensure process.

5) Please explain how outpatient services that are required in support of inpatient services pursuant to N.J.A.C. 8:43G-5.21 will be delivered. Would each campus provide outpatient services?

Response:

To be effective, outpatient clinic services do not need to be in the same building as inpatient services and should be accessible to local communities. As described in the response above to question #3, MMC works collaboratively with community providers to assure on a regular and continuing basis, the provision of outpatient and preventive services, including clinic services for

medically indigent patients are provided. The hospital has had a longstanding support agreement with Monmouth Family Health Center ("MFHC"), an FQHC with three locations in Long Branch. MFHC provides adult and pediatric medical services, dentistry, OB/GYN, Behavioral Health and Podiatry Services. MFHC provided a letter of support for this application and a copy was included in the original submission as Appendix 2. As discussed in the response to Question #3, MMC also provides specialty clinics which are not being relocated. These serve to meet the care continuity requirements of the hospital and best support inpatient services in the community and are not expected to change.

There are plans for Phase 1 of the Vogel Medical Campus for a comprehensive cancer center that includes outpatient diagnostic, treatment and physician specialty services. Further, there are discussions to have development of medical office space in proximity to the VMC. There are several affiliated Medical Groups and Specialty Groups providing services in the Long Branch/Tinton Falls areas including:

As confirmed in Question #1, outpatient imaging and surgery will remain in Long Branch including a mammography unit to complement the Breast Center that will be relocating to the VMC location.

As noted in the application, outpatient service demand is expected to continue to grow and the Medical Center is actively engaged in increasing outpatient services as part of its mission as a member of the RWJBarnabas Health System to partner with our communities to build and sustain a healthier New Jersey.

6) Department utilization statistics for the past five years show occupancy rates of between 24% and 28% for medical/surgical beds at Monmouth Medical Center. Please confirm whether these occupancy rates are accurate. If not, please provide the occupancy rates for the past three years.

Response:

The applicant confirms occupancy rates for licensed medical/surgical beds ranged from 24% to 28%. For ease of review, the statistics from the B2 report are provided in the table below.

7) Outpatient/same day surgery services and a post-anesthesia care unit (PACU) are planned for the new Fort Monmouth campus, with PACU services provided as support at the Long Branch facility. Please provide justification and further explanation about how the surgery and PACU services would operate at the new Fort Monmouth campus and how the Long Branch facility would provide PACU services as support.

Response:

There will be two separate PACU operations, one for the relocated hospital surgical services at the VMC and the second, for the converted ORs in the hospital's Cranmer Center to a licensed ambulatory surgery center at the Long Branch campus. The Cranmer Center was originally built as an ambulatory surgery center and provides a full spectrum of same-day surgical services using the most modern technology available. The facility includes four full-service operating rooms, one procedure room and two exam/treatment rooms and a three-tiered graduated recovery area, respecting the individual needs of adult and pediatric patients. The Cranmer Center will operate its six (6) existing PACU bays in accordance with N.J.A.C. 8:43 A ambulatory surgery standards for ambulatory care facilities.

In planning its services, MMC has considered historical demand as well as predicted trends. As noted in the application narrative, national consulting group, Sg2, projects outpatient demand by site of service for MMC's service area from 2023 to 2033 with hospital outpatient/ambulatory surgery expected to grow 10.8%, as major procedure grow at 19.2% and minor procedures at 12.2% (see narrative, page 43). The recent experience at MMC has been reflective of this growth.

MMC plans to meet the community increased need for outpatient surgery by continuing its outpatient surgical program at the Long Branch campus and relocating inpatient surgical services to the VMC and adding additional outpatient surgery capacity at this new site. MMC will meet hospital licensing standards N.J.A.C. 8:43 G for the VMC.

8) Will the observation beds at the Long Branch facility be designated exclusively for SED and same-day surgery patients, or are there plans to accommodate other types of patients as well?

Response:

The applicant confirms that the observation beds at the Long Branch location will be limited to the SED/SDS outpatient observation needs.

- 9) For the planned observation beds at the Long Branch facility, please provide the following information:
 - a. Will the beds be confined to a separate ward, or will they be scattered throughout the facility?
 - b. What protocols will be in place to quickly transfer patients to the new Fort Monmouth facility if they require admission or intensive care?
 - c. What are the planned hours of operation for the observation beds?
 - d. How will you ensure that specialists or emergency physicians are accessible to the Long Branch facility in a timely manner?
 - e. How will you provide nutrition and other daily needs to observation patients?

Response:

- The observation beds will be cohorted initially in an existing vacant inpatient unit proximate to the SED until such time as renovations are constructed for a new observation unit
- b. Protocols will be established with the Mobile Health team and EMS to identify patient appropriateness and patient transfer processes from the Long Branch campus to the new

- VMC location as required. Please refer to the response under Question #11 for additional details of the Patient Transfer Center.
- c. The observations beds will be 24/7/365.
- d. For routine and cross coverage, the same call schedule will be in place for both locations for specialists and emergency physicians. The specialist covering both locations can triage patients accordingly.
- e. Standard operations for dietary services and other required support service functions will be maintained for the observation patients and the behavioral health patients.
- 10) Please describe how staffing would be provided at each location. For each location, provide an explanation of staffing for each service. Please also identify potential waivers that would be needed for each location and service.

Response:

As noted in the responses provided to the third (3rd) completeness question and the change in scope of services at Long Branch, MMC expects that the two campuses will each have on-site personnel to meet all required licensing regulations for services that require on site presence or availability on call, including an administrator, anesthesiologist, nursing leader, and radiology tech.

An updated schedule J is included as Attachment 1 which details staffing by job title by site. We have also included a column for offsite clinic and service personnel that is not expected to change as a result of this project. Attachment 2 summarizes the staffing by Department.

The proposed project and staffing needs are configured to meet the demands of operating two campuses with increased ambulatory care services to meeting the projected increased demand for outpatient services by a growing population. There will be two sites for emergency services, ambulatory surgery, and diagnostic imaging. The additional 278 staff identified supports the planned increase in ambulatory service offerings at both campuses and the support staff necessary for efficient service operation (from environmental, plant operations, dietary, pharmacy, security, etc.).

In addition to the ambulatory services, the Long Branch campus will house the Psychiatric Inpatient services. As discussed above, this service had a higher patient origin from the local community.

As discussed in the application, MMC will be seeking waivers to utilize intensive care capacity (ICU/CCU and PICU) for step-down services at the VMC in efforts to assure maximum flexibility to meet the fluctuating patient care needs. No other waivers are anticipated at this juncture.

11) Please provide a plan for transporting patients from the old Long Branch facility to the new Fort Monmouth facility if there is a surge in demand when the Long Branch SED is operating at full capacity or cannot provide the services needed.

Response:

The Long Branch emergency department is comprised of 51 bays (inclusive of 5 PESS bays). A benchmark study by the HealthCare Advisory Board set the optimal range for ED efficiency at 1,700 to 2,000 annual visits per bed and explained that around 1,600 visits per ED bed was approaching optimal throughput with some cushion capacity. At 46 bays, the ED capacity is 73,600 visits. With PESS bays and an additional overflow capacity of 6 bays, the ED capacity expands to 91,200 visits. This built capacity readily addresses the ED visit volume of 45,715 visits seen in 2024. In May 2025, the average daily visits for the ED were around 122. There is a high level of excess capacity to minimize risk of capacity overflow.

Should a surge occur, the facility would execute its surge plan with its affiliate partners including Mobile Health team and hospital partners. Mobile Health operates a Patient Transfer Center providing a one call solution for transferring patients into and between any and all of the acutecare hospitals in the RWJBarnabas Health system. The Mobile Health Team works with the Satellite Emergency Department in Bayonne and their Surge Plan is attached as attachment 3.

For this proposed project and the SED, the surge plan would follow The Mobile Health team's standard transfer process. Once the SED determines it is hitting an operational threshold, or that they have a patient requiring a higher level of care, the attending physician at the SED would place a call to the RWJBarnabas Health Patient Transfer Center (PTC) at 732-926-4111. The Patient Transfer Center RN Coordinator will complete an intake from the sending provider and follow the normal transfer process of:

- Identifying the closest most appropriate facility with capabilities and capacity to take the patient.
- Connect the sending provider with an accepting provider for medical acceptance.
- Depending on the acuity of the patient and urgency of surge needs, the PTC would start to mobilize transport resources to the SED.
- The PTC will continue to facilitate the remaining logistics of the case including securing
 a bed or landing location at accepting facility for the patient, providing contact
 information for RN to RN hand off, ensuring the appropriate transport team the
 clinical information required to safely transport the patient, and provide updated
 ETA's for the sending and receiving teams.

If the number of patients requiring transfer exceed the normal volume, the Patient Transfer Center will escalate to the administrator on call (AOC) who would mobilize leadership of the PTC, Mobile Health EMS, and OnTime to ensure we can divert the appropriate number of resources to the SED to support the physical movement of the patients.

12) Please confirm that full morgue and autopsy services are planned for the new Fort Monmouth facility and provide an explanation for how the need for these services would be met at the Long Branch facility.

Response:

Morgue services will remain at the VMC location in Tinton Falls only. If required, transport would be arranged from the Long Branch location to VMC.

EXHIBIT A GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES FOR TRANSFER

A. Procedures

- 1. Transferring Facility shall contact the Receiving Facility's Transfer Center regarding the management, consultation, and transport of patients requiring intermediate and /or intensive care services (i.e. telephone co-management or total management).
- 2. Prior to any transfer, Transferring Facility shall:
 - a. Complete a transfer report in a form acceptable to the Receiving Facility;
 - b. Make every reasonable effort to contact the Receiving Facility and follow the transfer protocol outlined by the Receiving Facility
 - c. A copy of the transfer report shall accompany the patient to the Receiving Facility. The transfer report shall include but not be limited to:
 - (i) Current medical findings and diagnosis;
 - (ii) Name and contact information (name, address, cell telephone number and home and business telephone number, and relationship to the patient) of the individual(s) best able to provide key clinical information, and consent for procedures;
 - (iii) Rehabilitative potential and physical status;
 - (iv) Emotional and ambulation status;
 - (v) Summary of prior course of treatment, including recent physician progress notes;
 - (vi) Current prescribed medications and dosage;
 - (vii) Dietary needs and restrictions;
 - (viii) Pertinent administrative information including Medicare/Medicaid status and third-party payer information; and
 - (ix) Nursing information.
 - d. In addition to the foregoing information, Transferring Facility shall provide the following information:
 - (i) Whether the patient has executed an advance directive (i.e., a living will, durable power of attorney);
 - (ii) If applicable and if known, the name, address and home and business telephone number of the patient's attorney-in-fact (financial and/or durable) and/or the patient's legal guardian;
 - (iii) Name and telephone number of the patient's attending physician; and
 - (iv) Such other pertinent information as the transferring Institution may possess or the receiving Institution may request.
- 3. The Receiving Facility agrees to accept referrals of patients from Transferring Facility provided that (a) appropriate accommodations are available at the Receiving Facility; (ii) the patient satisfies the applicable requirements of the

- Receiving Facility; and (iii) Transferring Facility and Receiving Facility follow the agreed upon guidelines and procedures.
- 4. Patients transferred to Receiving Facility will be promptly returned to the Transferring Facility when the patient's condition dictates, in the Receiving Facility's sole discretion.
- 5. The Receiving Facility's attending physician will provide reports of the patient's condition and progress to the referring physician, as required. Sudden or unusual changes in the patient's condition will be reported separately.
